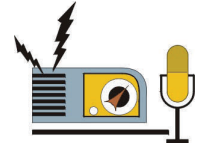

Share your Short Story on Radio



The Department of the Environment, within the Ministry of Natural Resources and the Environment, is inviting primary school students to share their creativity skills and write a short story about a current environmental issue in Belize.

1. The content of the short story should highlight any environmental issue currently applicable to Belize that other students can relate to.
2. The short story should be written by a primary school student, and only edited by a teacher or parent for grammar and coherency.
3. The short story must be no more than 200 words in length.
4. The short story should have a title.
5. One person per entry.
6. The short story must be legible, if not typewritten.
7. The short story must be original.
8. The short story labeled with the student's name, age, school and contact number.



All the things that go into making a Short Story

Students will:

- Have an opportunity to record their short story in person for airing over the radio
- Be able to identify their school
- Receive a small honorary package
